## CAMP EVANGELIST

Rev. Rodger Moyer grew up in a Pastoral home with the Evangelical United Brethren Church. His father later served as Director of Peniel Missions in California, Oregon, and Washington for World Gospel Mission. His mother was director of an unwed mothers' home.

Rodger was called to the ministry at a Camp Meeting at the age of 6. In 1985 he graduated from Vennard Bible College and has been pastoring in the East Central Conference of the Evangelical Church since that time.

He was ordained in 1987. He pastored in Marion, Ohio for three years; Shiloh, Ohio for 10 years; and is presently in his 19th year pastoring Sturgis Evangelical Church in Sturgis, Michigan.

Over the past 30 years Rev. Moyer has been blessed to have preached many revival meetings and in several Camp meetings throughout the United States.
